Essel Infra Bags 3 Waste-to-Energy Projects in AP

Hyderabad: Essel Infra-projects (EIL), part of Subhash Chandra-led Essel group, has announced securing three waste-to-energy projects in the cities of Kadapa, Anantapur and Tadepalli Gudem in Andhra Pradesh.

■ **EIL has awarded the contract to Hitachi Zosen India**

EIL has awarded the contract to Hitachi Zosen India for delivery of the projects with a processing capacity of 990 tonne a day and power output of around 18,000 kilowatt.

Earlier, EIL and Hitachi Zosen India had worked together in delivering waste-to-energy plant in Jabalpur of Madhya Pradesh. The total capacity of four waste-to-energy projects of Essel group are expected to reach 0.57 million tonne a year by 2019, the company said in a statement.
