

## **Essel Infraprojects Sets Up ₹100-crore TN plant**

**CHENNAI** Essel Group firm Essel Infraprojects has commissioned its maiden “waste-to-energy” plant in Tamil Nadu, set up at an investment of ₹100 crore.
